For example, economic stimulus packages being drawn up by governments offer an excellent opportunity to ensure that clean and sustainable technologies investments continue and even increase. That was the purpose of the recent statement published jointly by EMIRI and other European organizations of the green-tech sector, calling for continued climate leadership ambitions.
